Well 2 months have gone since my last letter and so much has been happening here in the schools worker office, I have met with people in many of the schools in the area and tried to find out what each school needs and how we can help, this has been a very fruitful experience.

We had our first “Wired” even at Shoreline church in October when New Generation came and delivered some training to some high school children and youth leaders about running effective Christian groups in schools and being visible in their schools. It was a great success and many young people went away feeling encouraged, equipped and empowered.

I have also been into a number of primary schools with some volunteers recently to deliver assemblies for anti bullying week.

From the 1st to the 11th of December we are in the primary schools again looking with the Christmas presentation “Where has Christmas gone ?” At the time of writing we have 19 primary schools booked in which is tremendously exciting. The simple message of the story is of a young girl who suspects that the true meaning of Christmas has been stolen and with a little help from the President of the USA enlists the help of some “Super Heroes” to find it, I know it's exciting isn't it and it promises to be a lot of fun surrounding the important message that Christmas begins with CHRIST.
