Our annual interactive, informative and fun Easter experience: Mission Impossible? for Year 6 children is just couple of weeks away.

This is a 90 minute presentation, held at Scarisbrick New Road Baptist Church, designed to give the children the opportunity to conduct their own research investigating the events of the Easter story, discovering what took place 2000 years ago and deciding if they think it was Mission Impossible? Or not.

The children are invited to train to become 'Secret Agents' and through drama, video, games and music they will be guided through the key events of the Easter story, by local Christian Youth workers and volunteers from churches. They will move around the training base to visit a doctor's surgery, witness the trial of Jesus, find clues in the Garden of Gethsemane, hear an eyewitness account and complete their Secret Agent 'passport' to record their findings.

It is such a fun presentation as well communicating clearly the message of Easter and allowing the children to make up their own minds about what happened.
